The Community Mental Health Board (CMHB) plans, develops, coordinates, evaluates and disburses funds to mental health services in Oak Park for persons with mental disorders, alcohol or other drug dependence or developmental disorders.

The CMHB was formed in 1973 and operates under the Illinois law known as the Community Mental Health Act. The Act provides that a township has the power to provide community mental health services as defined by the community mental health board. The CMHB members are appointed pursuant the Community Mental Health Act which provides for the Township Supervisor, with the advice and consent of the governing body, to establish up to a 9 member community mental health board.
