Can teen substance use and abuse be prevented?

To help prevent substance use:



- **Talk to your child** early about what you expect in his or her behavior toward alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs. If your teen thinks that you will allow substance use, he or she is more likely to try drugs or alcohol.
- **Keep your teen busy** with meaningful activities, such as sports, church programs, or other groups.
- **Expect your teen** to follow the household rules. Set reasonable consequences for behavior that needs to change, and consistently carry out the consequences.
- **Listen.**
- **Know your child's friends.** Having friends who avoid cigarettes, alcohol, and drugs may be your teen's best protection from substance abuse.

Pillars offers treatment for teens and adults who are diagnosed with substance use disorders. Adolescent Outpatient and Intensive Outpatient Addictions Services: Our Adolescent Services provide treatment for teens ages 12-17 who are at risk for or are diagnosed with a mild or more severe substance use disorder. Staff offer a comprehensive assessment to determine level of care and a treatment plan. Services are offered in Hickory Hills and La Grange Park.

All of our services for adolescents and families begin with a comprehensive substance abuse assessment.

Intensive Outpatient Treatment Program (IOP) - Designed to help adolescents who are struggling with drinking or substance abuse problems.

Teen Intervention Program (TIP) - 4-session outpatient program designed to provide education and early intervention. It meets weekly and includes family involvement. Continuing Care - Ongoing weekly support groups for newly recovering teens and their parents. Services are offered in Melrose Park and Westchester.
