

Eric E. Davis Township Trustee

Eric Davis was elected as Township Trustee in May 2017 for a 4-year term. He is a licensed architect and the Deputy Director of the Cook County Department of Capital Planning and Policy. Eric has worked in the field for 30 years, almost entirely for or with public agencies.

Eric has served as a volunteer member of the Township Youth Services Committee and as a Commissioner of the Oak Park Housing Authority. On his decision to become a trustee, Eric said, "I was pleased during my first two terms to serve as the board liaison to, first, the Youth Services Committee, and then to the Senior Services Committee. During that time I was particularly proud to be able to play a significant role in identifying, acquiring, and renovating the building for our new Senior Services Center. To start this term, I have already put forward my desire to be the board liaison to the Community Mental Health Board, the only major area of Township activity that I do not have much experience with, and my fellow Board members, and our new Supervisor, have supported that request. Given the synergies and overlap these days between the three areas, youth, seniors, and those with mental health challenges (and their families), it is more exciting than ever to be able to help advance services to these especially vulnerable members of our community." Eric will be serving as liaison to the Youth Services Department.

Along with his wife, Suzanne, and their sons John and Kevin, Eric has lived in Oak Park for 17 years. Both sons went to public schools here through high school.
