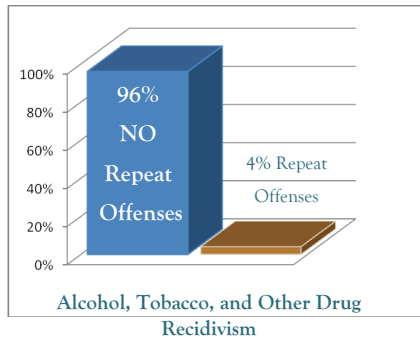

### Goals

Empower families to help youth avoid using alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs.

### Outcomes

#### Family Members

- Learn about the consequences and effects of using alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs
- Learn, practice, and apply healthy life skills
- Improve family communication and relationships

#### Youth

- Reduce incidents of alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use and possession at school and in the community

#### Parents and Caregivers

- Enhance parenting skills and tools
- Develop and provide clear family rules and consequences regarding the use of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs

### Number of Sessions

Participants graduate after completing eight (8-12) sessions (one session weekly)

Mandatory Parent/Caregiver attendance for each session.
