Advisory Referenda Petitions as presented to the Township Clerk by March 1, 2012

### Petition

We, the undersigned voters in the township of Oak Park, in Cook County, in the State of Illinois and pursuant to (60 ILCS 1/30-10) Sec. 30/10, and Section 28-1 et seq. of the Election Code do hereby petition the township board to add the following item to the agenda for the annual township meeting on April 10, 2012:  
**Shall the following advisory question of public policy be placed on the ballot for submission to the voters in the township of Oak Park, in Cook County, in the State of Illinois, for the November 6, 2012 election:**

#### **Non-binding Referendum regarding Citizens United & Electoral Finances**

As the undue influences of SuperPACs and corporate power on our electoral process are greatly diminishing the ability of We the People to have a voice in our electoral process and to obtain fair representation of the broader interests of We the People within our government,

Shall the People of Oak Park stand with communities across the country in requesting that our village, county, state, and federal representatives enact resolutions and legislation, including consideration for amending the Constitution of the United States to establish that: a) Political money is not the same as speech, and therefore that money shall be regulated; and b) The rights guaranteed by the Constitution were and are primarily intended for human beings, not corporations?

We the undersigned registered voters in the Village of Oak Park would like to have the following placed on the ballot for the next general election:

**"Shall those companies who wish to drill for, or supply, natural gas derived from hydraulic fracking techniques be required to inform residents of Oak Park Township of the hazardous chemicals and risks in the process and be prohibited from supplying natural gas derived from hydraulic fracking to Oak Park Township customers."**
