There have been some parent complaints so an increase in referrals back to the FACE-it program are expected.

**New Business: Contract review**

- River Forest Library – Connections program
  - Motion to fund at \$7,812.32 made by Sarah M.
  - Motion Seconded by Dick B.
  - Motion passes unanimously

Rationale: The committee believes the close proximity of the library to the middle school is important and helps ensure that youth are able to and will attend this program.

- RFPD – I Search
  - This program serves a much broader age range than what the committee would like to focus on.
  - Committee members wonder when presentations are happening and would like more info on the program in general.
  - Contract tabled. Committee members have some follow up questions they would like the program administrator to answer before revisiting request.
- CUC Robotics – Stem 4NE-1
  - Motion to fund at \$15,262.00 made by Sarah M.
  - Motion seconded by Dick B.
  - Motion passes unanimously

Rationale: Past performance has shown the success of the program. Both parents and youth have provided positive feedback on the camp.
